Area of Production: San Carlo, a one hectare vineyard in Castiglione Tinella, Piedmont - Italy

Varietal: 100% Pinot Noir

Alcohol: 13.5%

Wine Notes: Saracco Pinot Noir combines the traditional delicate bouquet of red berries and a velvety taste with good acidity, round body, complex structure and high persistence on the palate.

Wine Making Techniques: Vinification in stainless steel tanks, refining using new and old barrels. After bottling, the wine is aged for an additional 6 months before releasing.

Recommended Food: Pairs with grilled salmon, pasta with porcini mushrooms as well as roasted duck.
