2014 Vintage Report

The vintage 2014 had a delay of about 15 to 20 days compared to the previous year. The amount of production decreased approximately 15%. The trend of cool and rainy spring and summer seasons is the reason why we needed more effort to manage the vineyard, to encourage the grapes to ripen and to contain the damage caused by pests, with an increased cost of production. The white and rosé wines showed very good aromatic characteristic accompanied by excellent freshness and elegance. Red grapes have had a slowly and gradually phenolic ripening. The good weather conditions during the months of September and October allowed us to achieve a high quality of excellence.
